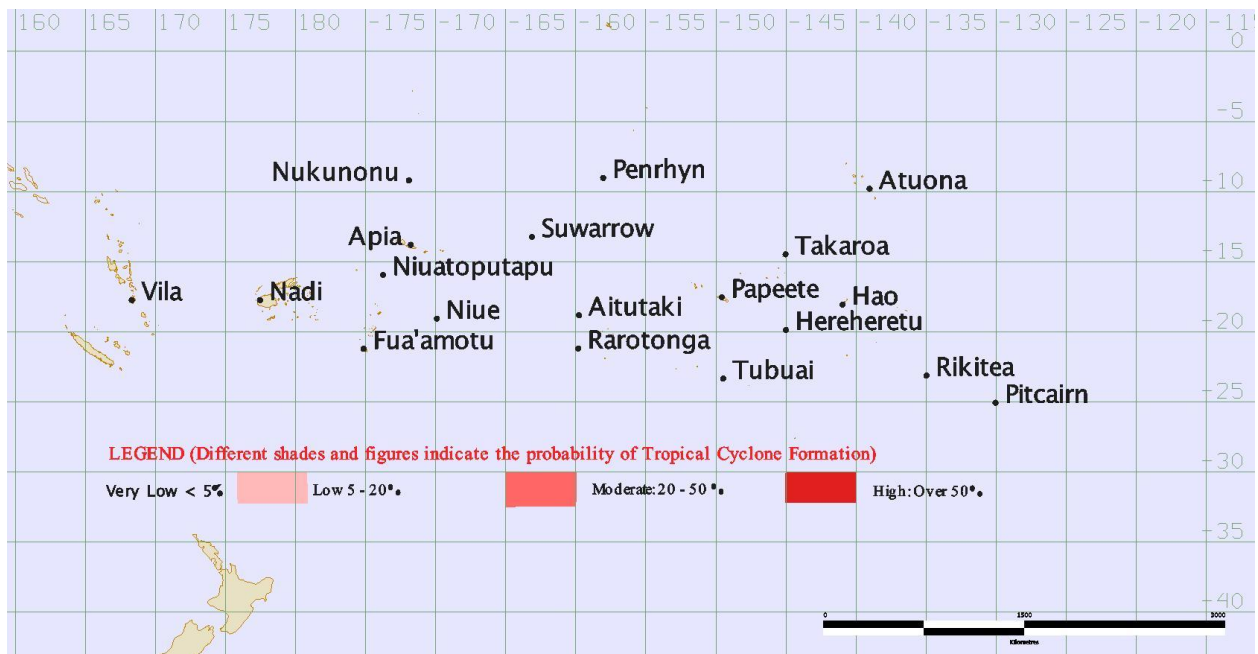

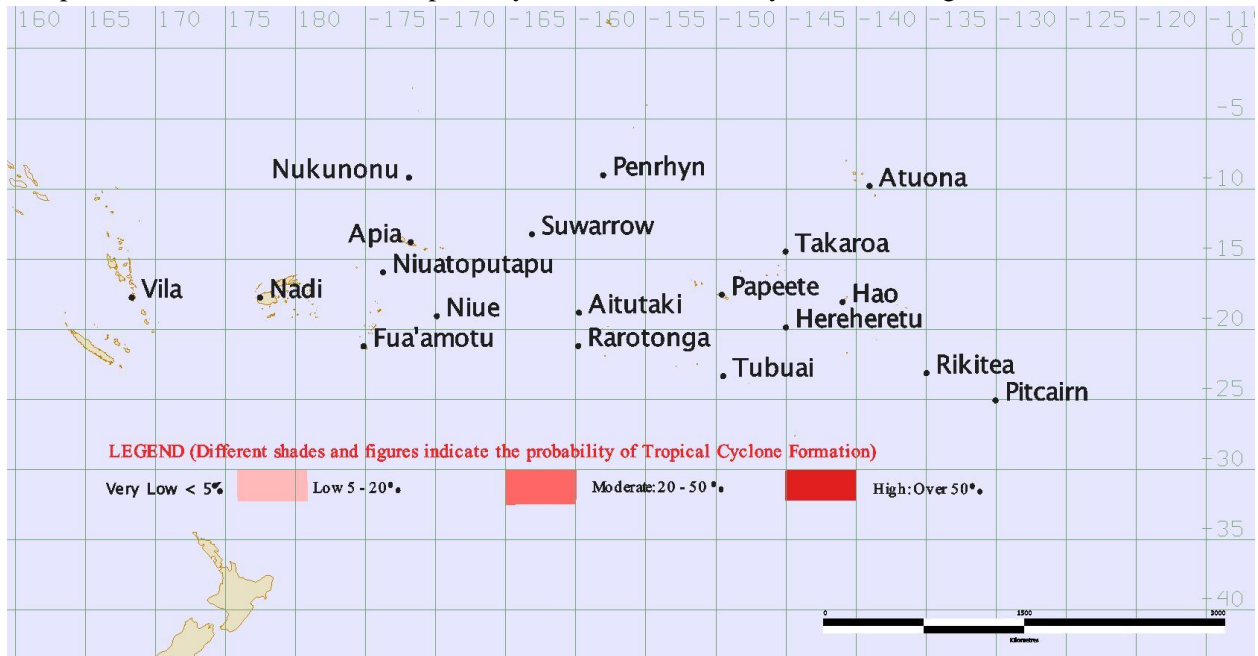
Saturday 14^h January

The potential for formation of a Tropical Cyclone in the region is **VERY LOW**.



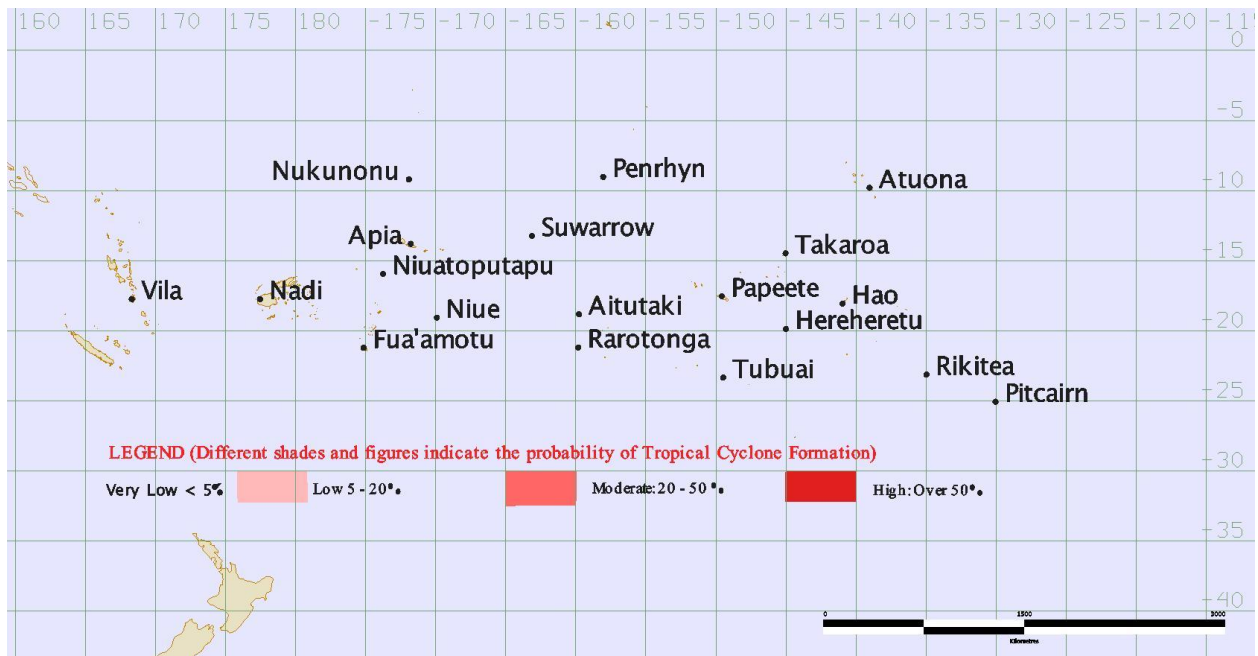
Sunday 15^h January

Monday 16th January

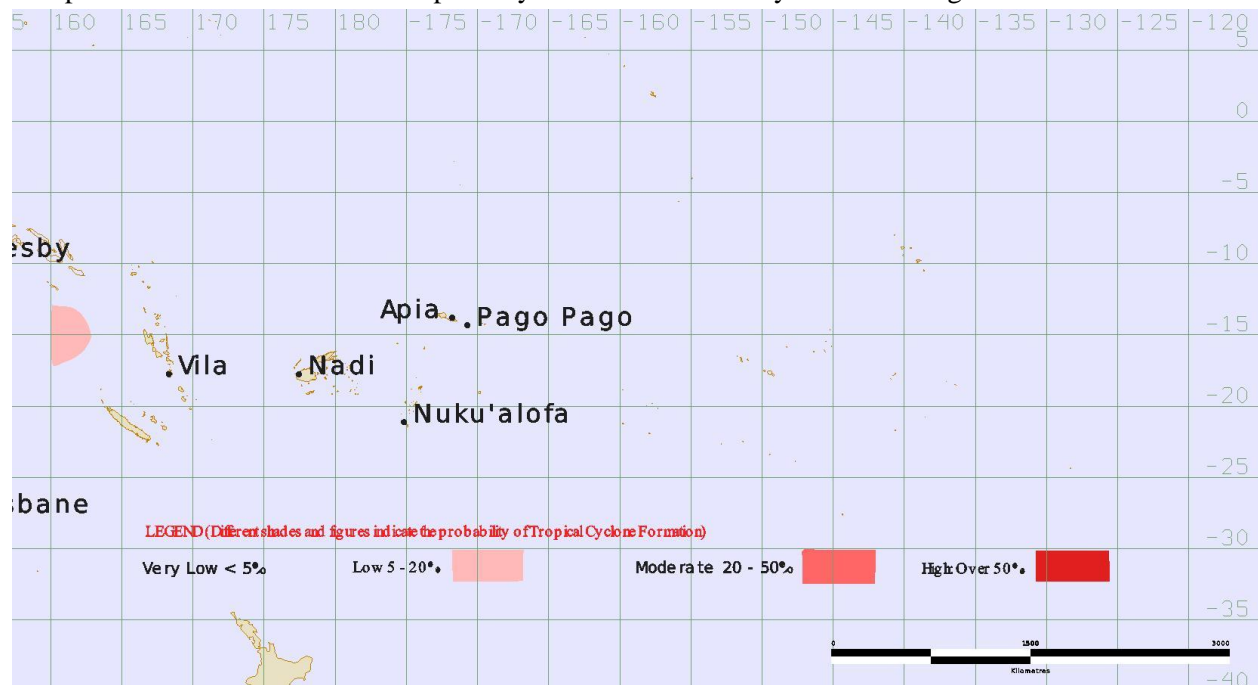
